The Walk-for-Life T-shirt sales went well. All but 4 were sold and we turned in over \$1,000.00 in donations to the Emerald Coast Coalition for Life. The Walk-for-Life on the 14th of January also went well. The speakers were excellent and even though Roe vs Wade was overturned the number of abortions in the state of Florida has gone up. The battle to have all life protected under law still must go on.

Our council has now donated \$1,000.00 each to the Majella House and the Life Options Clinic qualifying us to receive an additional \$200.00 from the Supreme Council to add to each donation. A majority of the funds donated came from our monthly charity breakfasts. With the help of the donations from the January breakfast we were able to send \$1,000.00

# Deacon's Teaching By Deacon Chris Christopher Why do Catholic Bibles Have 73 Books?

It's still a jolt for some people that the complete Bible did not fall out of the sky leatherbound in 95 A.D. Rather, the

New Testament canon slowly developed over a period of about 500 years, even longer for the Old Testament. That does not mean the New Testament was written 500 years ago; it means it took the Church all that time to sift the wheat from the chaff in determining which books were deemed God inspired and which were not.

Since we only have copies of all books of the Bible - no originals exist – the Church relied on Tradition to determine which of those copies were inspired by God. Therefore, since Jesus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament scriptures, and His Church existed before any New Testament scriptures were even written, the Church existed first and then later compiled the Bible. Hence, the authority of the Bible depends on the authority of the Church.

# So, why does the Protestant Bible have only 66 Books?

Approximately 200 years before Christ, the Jews assembled 72 biblical scholars to translate the Hebrew Scriptures into Greek; Greek was the everyday language in the Holy Land at that time, not Hebrew. Hebrew had ceased to be a spoken language as early as the exilic or post-exilic period. Hence, there was a need for a scholarly translation of the Hebrew Scriptures into Greek. This translation of the Old Testament Scriptures is referred to as The Septuagint (septa being the Latin ordinal number for 70). This 3rd Cent. B.C. translation served as the Old Testament Scriptures for Jesus and the apostles, and for all the generations

henceforth.

When Martin Luther broke from Catholicism in the 16th Cent., he eliminated some books from the Septuagint that had been in use since 200 B.C. Although he insisted that Scripture alone [Sola Scriptura] must be the sole authority for the Christian faith, he excised certain texts from the Septuagint that did not support his teachings; and he did so on his own authority [The Protestant and Catholic New Testaments are identical, however, Luther even questioned some of its books].

The New Testament canon was pretty much settled by the 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> Cent. Since the Old Testament canon was settled 200 yrs. before Christ, the Church had no need to discuss its veracity. So, the question is often asked, 'If the Old and New Testaments were settled by the 5<sup>th</sup> Cent., why did it take the Council of Trent in the 16<sup>th</sup> Cent. to finally close the entire Canon of Scripture?'

Like nearly all Church Councils, they are convened when there is trouble in the Church that needs to be settled. In this case, it was over which books constituted the Old Testament due to Luther's excising some of them. The Council's decision was that only those Books of the Bible that had been in continual use for the last 1500 years will constitute the Canon, and thus the Canon was closed to any further additions or subtractions.



#### **Supreme Chaplain's Challenge** by Archbishop William E. Lori

"But I say to you, do not swear at all Challenge by Supreme Chaplain .... Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes,' and your 'No' mean 'No.' Anything more is from the evil one." (Gospel for Feb. 12, Mt 5:34a, 37)

Jesus here decries casual oaths that offend God, but all sorts of deceitful, blasphemous or obscene language is frequently heard in our society today. Taking the Lord's name in vain — or misusing our gift of speech in other ways has become commonplace. Showing respect for God is fundamental to the Christian life and doing so in our speech is a pivotal place to start. Let's speak plainly and keep our speech pure and true to honor God.

# Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to mindfully practice curbing your tongue, particularly avoiding taking the Lord's name in vain. Second, I challenge you to seek to grow in your respect for God as a Catholic man by participating in the Faith in Action Into the Breach program.

#### **Questions for Reflection:**

Do you pay much attention to what you say and how you say it? Do you notice what you hear around you, whether from the people in your life or from media you consume? What are some specific ways you can try to avoid speech that fails to show respect for God?
